## *News from the Milner Gardens and Woodland Society*

I am pleased to announce the Society has a trading account with RBC Dominion Securities to enable donations of gifts of stock for support of programs at Milner. This new avenue for giving to Milner was made possible by an anonymous gift of stock in support of our Phase II Campaign launched this summer to help stabilize the operating budgets and support the programs.

The Society is also exploring the opportunity to have the Vancouver Foundation, one of Canada's largest operating foundations, provide services for investment of our funds to maximize the potential support for funds generated by the Phase II Campaign.

The Board of the MG&W Society will discuss some changes to the benefits to our donor giving categories. We hope to have these changes completed before the end of November. One of the changes would enable donors to utilize 10% of their donations, up to a maximum of \$50.00, to provide for membership or complimentary garden passes for visitors. For example, a donation of \$400.00 would provide a complimentary household membership or five guest passes at \$7.50 each as part of the donation; a donation of \$250 would provide a complimentary individual membership or three guest passes. These changes reflect current federal government provisions for donations to registered charities.

These changes will provide new opportunities for our many donors to help keep our programs operating while at the same time giving additional benefits to our donors.

We are confident that our target Phase II 2005 Campaign of \$75,000 to help defray operating expenses will be successfully reached before the end of the year. I want to thank our many donors for their support in helping us to reach this target. Best wishes for a great holiday season and a healthy and prosperous New Year with good gardening!
