Terms of awards

- 1 Applicants must have graduated from a high school located on Vancouver Island.
- 2 Applicants must be Canadian citizens or landed immigrants.
- 3 Applicants must be proceeding into second year engineering in an accredited engineering program, or be transferring from a bridging program at a technical institute into either second year or third year of an accredited engineering program.
- 4 Applicants must have completed the previous year of their engineering or technical institute program with at least a 'B' grade average.

The criteria for granting of awards includes the following:

- Academic standing;
- Financial need;
- Other considerations or special circumstances.

Application

Applicants must complete the accompanying form (two pages), and:

- 1 Attach a copy of the transcript of their marks from the previous year in the engineering/technical institute program; and,
- 2 Attach assessment letters from the Department Head or Dean certifying that the applicant is either entering second year engineering at a accredited university or has met the requirements of a university transfer program to enable transfer to second year or third year engineering at an accredited university. The assessment letter should include the number of students in the program and the candidate's position ranking in the overall class during the previous year of their engineering/technical institute program.
