Nanaimo - a beautiful city on the scenic east coast of Vancouver Island, British Columbia - is ideally located: close to the ocean, estuaries, streams and rivers, and lakes, all of which are utilized in the teaching programs. Near the campus are Federal and Provincial laboratories, salmonid enhancement hatcheries, and numerous private shellfish farms, salmon hatcheries and fish farms. Students gain invaluable work experience at these sites as part of their practicum work experience courses.

The Fisheries and Aquaculture facilities support applied research, education, training and technology transfer on fish and invertebrate culture, habitat and stock assessment, conservation and management.

The **Centre for Shellfish Research (CSR)** is a valuable resource to both faculty and Students. The CSR addresses scientific and technical issues of the shellfish aquaculture industry, as well as social and economic concerns in coastal communities.
