

HEAVY EQUIPMENT OPERATOR PROGRAMS –2010

HEO Foundation: This 4 week course has been developed with the support of the BC Road Builders & Heavy Construction Association as a pre-employment program. It gives an overview of the industry including safe work practices, environmental requirements, orientations to equipment and tools, and an introduction to civil engineering principles. Foundations will satisfy the pre-requisite requirements for the HEO Technician (Apprenticeship) program and for other heavy construction apprenticeship programs currently being developed; including asphalt paving, utility installation and road maintenance. The following certifications are provided:

- Occupational First Aid
- Traffic Control
- Workplace Hazardous Materials Information Systems (WHMIS)
- ITA Certificate of Completion

ITA HEO Technician Certificate Program: This is an Industry Training Authority apprenticeship program for those pursuing a certificate of qualification for the operation of one or more types of heavy equipment. Graduates will be registered apprentices and can then begin ‘logging’ the operating hours and competencies required for endorsement either through our HEO Machine Training Program or through immediate employment in industry. This 5 week course builds on the general heavy construction content of the Foundations program with additional training specific to heavy equipment including:

- Worksite health and safety
- Types and capabilities of heavy equipment and attachments
- Heavy equipment mechanical systems
- Basic repairs, maintenance, inspection & monitoring of equipment
- Job control and engineering basics, drawings, survey instruments
- Environmental awareness and requirements, sediment control

Students will receive orientations to excavator, dozer, loader, and articulated rock truck including extensive practical training for pre-operational checks and maintenance, identification of mechanical components, operating tips and 3 hours of seat time on each machine type for a total of 12 hours. Students are encouraged to choose one of the equipment types and continue to develop operating competency through our HEO Machine Training Program.

HEO Machine Training: *Prices subject to change without notice***

This intensive hands-on program provides students with the operating fundamentals and ‘seat time’ experience to develop entry level competency as a heavy equipment operator. Students learn essential operating fundamentals by completing practical earth moving exercises. A step-by-step progression introduces increasingly advanced skills and operating principles. Pre-operational checks, equipment maintenance, interpretation of drawings and grades stakes, basic grade checking instruments, and constant reinforcement of safety are important elements of the training. The program provides 3 to 8 weeks of training, (25 hours per week) depending on the machine type: Registration ongoing.

INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS:

HEO Programs run 25 hours a week, either Monday to Thursday or Tuesday to Friday. All programs take place at our training site on Timberlands Road (by Nanaimo airport).

Admission to the HEO programs requires that students be 18 years of age, have grade 10 or equivalent education, possess a valid driver's license and be physically fit. Please note that Assessment testing is required for acceptance into the HEO Foundation program.

Students must provide their own safety equipment; hard hat, high-visibility vest, hearing protection, gloves (pack of 10), a watch, and steel-toed boots. An eye level is also required. Training will not start if students do not have the proper safety equipment.

Once program requirements have been met and a program seat has been offered, students are required to pay a commitment fee to hold their place in the program. This deposit is non-refundable. If a student is being sponsored for their training, a letter of sponsorship from the appropriate agency is required at time of registration. Cancellation of a sponsored student will result in a charge to the sponsoring agency of the commitment fee.

There is a one-time VIU application fee of \$35 for these programs.
