As you prepare for your career in the health and human services, develop the knowledge and skills you will need to deal effectively with challenging behaviour and potentially dangerous situations. How you respond greatly determines the safety of everyone involved—and profoundly impacts the relationships with those in your care. **Are you prepared?**

***Nonviolent Crisis Intervention<sup>®</sup> Training*** gives you the skills and knowledge to:

- Respond effectively when confronted by anxious, hostile, or violent behavior;
- Deal with your own stress and emotions;
- De-escalate potentially dangerous behavior;
- Safely intervene should physical restraint techniques become necessary;
- Promote dignity and safety – even in challenging situations.
