Gromme had a great weekend for the Mariners as her squad split the weekend with UBC Okanagan. On Friday night, Gromme tallied 16 points, 5 rebounds, 7 assists and 2 steals in a 81-61 win over previously unbeaten UBCO. On Saturday, Kayla scored 21 points in a 78-75 loss to UBCO.

Kayla is currently 4th in league assists with a 3.44 assists per game average, and 11th in scoring with a 11.89 PPG.
