Structure

Malaspina University-College's MBA/MScIB Dual Degree program is offered in an intensive 14-month, full-time format which includes a 4-month Internship and Applied Business Project. Students without an undergraduate degree in business are expected to complete an additional 2-month Foundation Program before the start of the MBA/MScIB program.

Start Dates

Non-business Graduates: July and October

Business Graduates: September and January

Application Deadlines

Non-Business Graduates: May 30 for the July start date and Aug 31 for the October start date

Business Graduates: June 30 for the September start date and Oct 31 for the January start date

General Admission Requirements

- University bachelor's degree from a recognized, accredited institution, from a business or non-business program, with a minimum "B" average in the last 2 years
- Letter of intent, resume, 2 letters of recommendation from past employers or professors must be included as part of the application
- Work experience preferred but not required
- No GMAT Required
- Malaspina English language requirement for International applicants

MBA/MScIB: \$18,500 CAD

(includes textbooks & internship placement) + student fees

International Students

Foundation Program: (non-business graduates)

\$4,850 CAD + student fees & textbooks

MBA/MScIB: \$29,500 CAD
