

BYLAW #9
Tuition and Other Mandatory Student Fees

Approved: August 21, 1979

Amended: March 2010

Programs and Activities Funded by the Ministry of Advanced Education & Labour Market Development (ALMD) and Industry Training Authority (ITA)

Further to Article 27 (2) (m) of the University Act, the Board has the authority to set Tuition and Other Mandatory Student Fees for programs and activities which are funded by ALMD and ITA.

The Board may, from time to time, approve amendments to such fees and approve new additional fees upon the recommendation of the Executive. Approval will be by simple majority vote at a regular meeting following an earlier regular meeting at which notice was given of the intent to amend fees. Fees, including those amended, will be recorded in a numbered appendix to this Bylaw entitled Fee Schedule #XXX Pursuant to Bylaw #9.

Approved fee amendments and approved new additional fees will be conveyed by the University Secretary to the Registrar and Director of Enrolment Services for implementation and to the Director of Communications and Public Relations for inclusion in the Calendar and other forms of communication and marketing.

Tuition fees may be standard fees which apply to most programs or differential fees which apply to specific programs. Other Mandatory Student Fees may be standard to most programs or specific to one or more programs. Other Mandatory Fees will be identified by their purpose.

Fees for international students in programs, which are funded by ALMD and ITA, will generally be set at a level equivalent to the amount paid by domestic students plus the amount funded by ALMD and ITA. This basis for setting of international fees may be tempered according to market conditions.

Programs and Activities Not Funded by the Ministry of Advanced Education & Labour Market Development (ALMD) and Industry Training Authority (ITA)

Authority for the setting of Tuition Fees and Other Mandatory Student Fees for programs and activities, which are not funded by ALMD or ITA, is delegated by the Board to the Executive.

Upon submission by the appropriate Dean of a business plan for each program, the Executive will approve the business plan and the fees to be charged to participating students or the sponsoring/contracting agency.

The level of fees will be market driven and appropriate to the business plan. Consequently, fees will generally differ from those charged for programs, which are funded by ALMD or ITA.

The Executive will convey details of fees to the Registrar and Director of Enrolment Services for implementation and to the Director of Communications and Public Relations for inclusion in the Calendar and other forms of communication and marketing.
