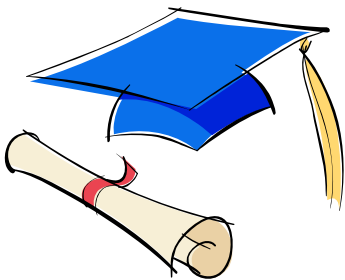

Gilles Novaks is a Montagnais Indian from Montreal. He is a Medicine Man and a Healer. He has asked that we get as many Tribal people as possible to participate in a worldwide ceremony called the '8,000 Drums'. He was contacted by two Huron Clan Grandmothers and they asked him to help spread the word to all Indians everywhere. It will take place on March 21, 2008 at 12:00 noon . All you need to do is play a drum either alone, or with a group or have the whole Tribe participate. The purpose is to fulfill the OTOMI PROPHECY. The Otomi's are Mayan Olmec and Toltec descendants. The drums will be played so that the Creator will hear us and grant our wishes as we pray for help in the Healing Process of our Mother Earth. ...
