Sunday July 1st, CANADA DAY

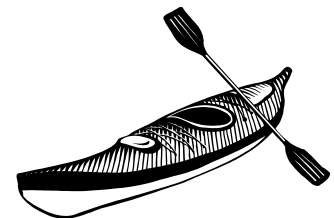
