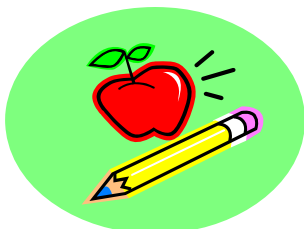
Important Dates
