From Vancouver Island University's website (www.viu.ca), click on "Become a Student" and follow the link to PASBC (www.pas.bc.ca).

This *Application for Admission* can be delivered or mailed to any campus – Nanaimo, Cowichan, Powell River, or Parksville-Qualicum.

Please ensure you have completed all sections of the *Application for Admission*. Current high school students from British Columbia and the Yukon should provide their Personal Education Number (PEN).

Pay the Application Fee

A \$35 non-refundable, one-time application fee is required from all new applicants to undergraduate programs. If you have previously applied to Vancouver Island University (Malaspina) and have paid the application fee, you do not need to pay this fee again.

A \$100 application fee is required from all applicants to graduate programs (Masters). A \$100 application fee must be paid each time you apply to a graduate program and it is non-refundable.

Submit Official Transcripts

Both high school and post-secondary transcripts are required from new applicants to undergraduate programs. Transcripts become the property of Vancouver Island University and will not be returned.

Current high school students from BC and the Yukon will provide their PEN and may be required to submit an interim transcript for admission purposes.

Only post-secondary transcripts are required from applicants to graduate programs.

Processing of Your Application

Within three weeks of receiving your application, Vancouver Island University will send you an acknowledgement letter.

Additional letters may request information to complete your application. **Please read the letters carefully and call if you have any questions.**

Acceptance to Vancouver Island University

Upon admission to a program, a letter of acceptance will be mailed to you. To confirm your acceptance of an offer of admission, a \$200 deposit will be required. For some programs, the deposit may be more. The due date to accept the offer and pay the deposit will be outlined in the letter of acceptance.

Students are responsible for informing the Registration Centre of any change of address. For all matters, the University considers it to be sufficient notification to mail information to the student's address as recorded with the Registration Centre.
