


Downloading Pictures from a Canon PowerShot Digital Still Camera using the Camera's USB Interface Cable

1. Log in to a computer with your Discovery or Capitan account.
2. Make sure the camera is **on** and the mode switch on the back of the camera is set to  : "Playback" mode.



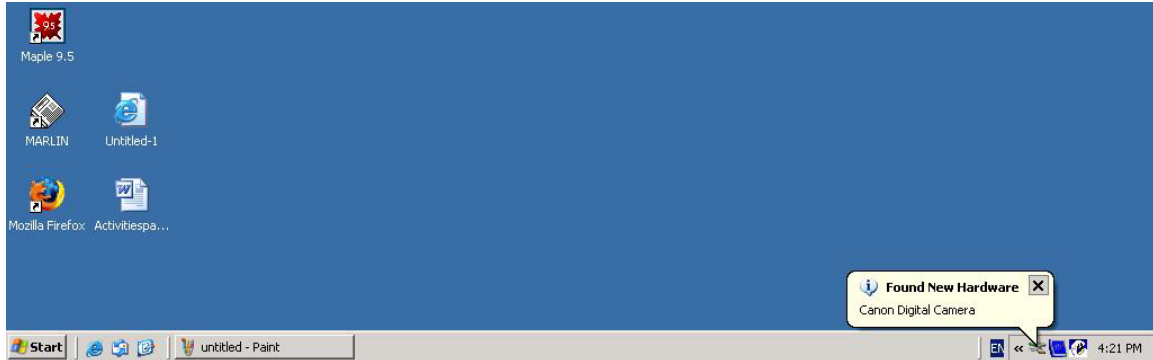
3. Plug the smaller end of the USB interface cable into the camera. You will find the port on the left side of the camera, under a rubber flap:



4. Plug the larger end of the USB interface cable into a USB port on the computer:



5. The computer will detect the camera:



6. Windows may ask if you want to launch the Scanner and Camera Wizard:

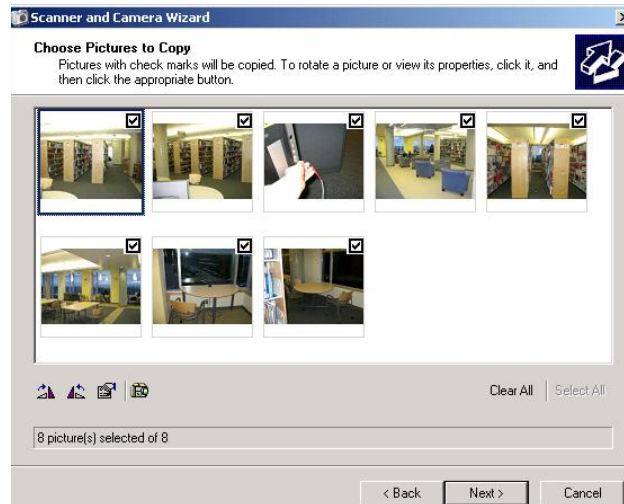


Click OK. *N.B. if you do not see the above dialogue box, skip to step 13.*

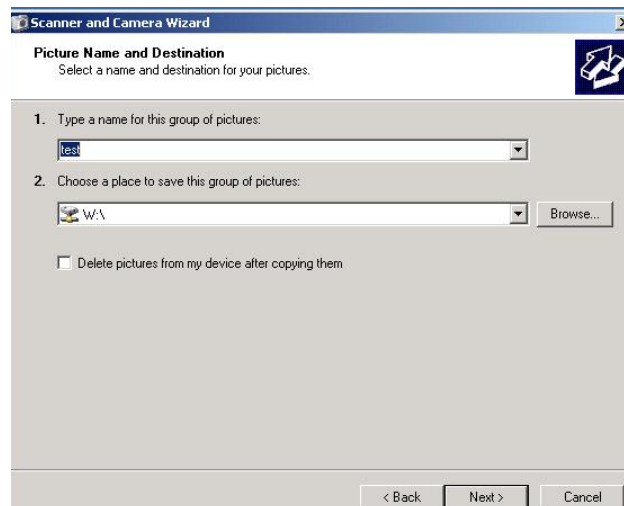
7. Click Next at the first screen of the Scanner and Camera Wizard:



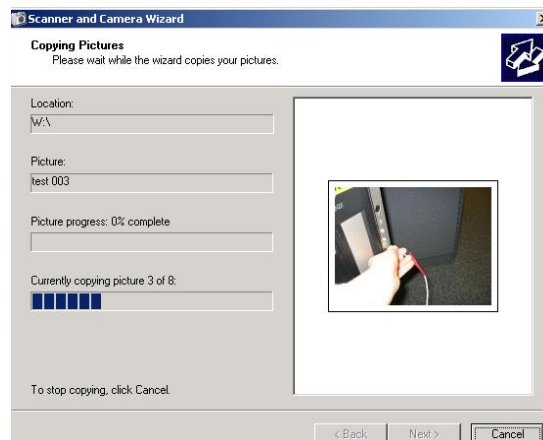
8. The next screen of the wizard will display the pictures on the camera. By default, all the pictures will be selected for copying (i.e. downloading). De-select any pictures you don't want copied by clicking the appropriate check boxes to remove the tick. Click Next.



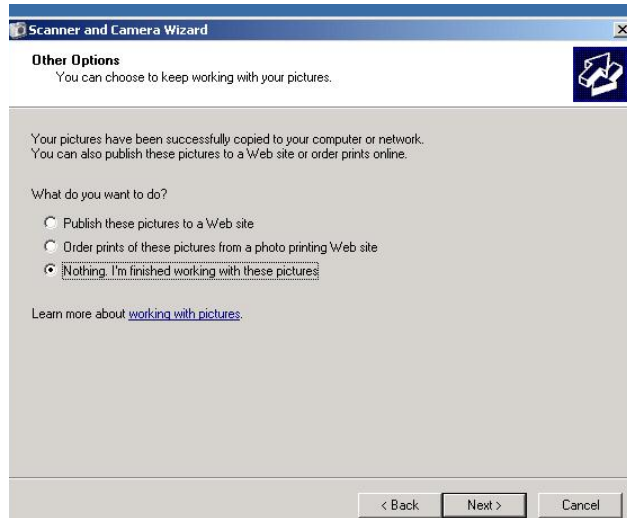
9. On the "Picture Name and Destination" screen of the wizard, 1) give a name to the group of pictures (this name will be included in the filename of each picture), and 2) click the Browse button to choose a location to save your files (e.g. your U: drive on Discovery.) You can delete the pictures immediately after copying them by selecting the "Delete pictures..." check box, or leave the check box unticked if you'd like to delete them later. Click Next.



10. Your pictures will be copied...



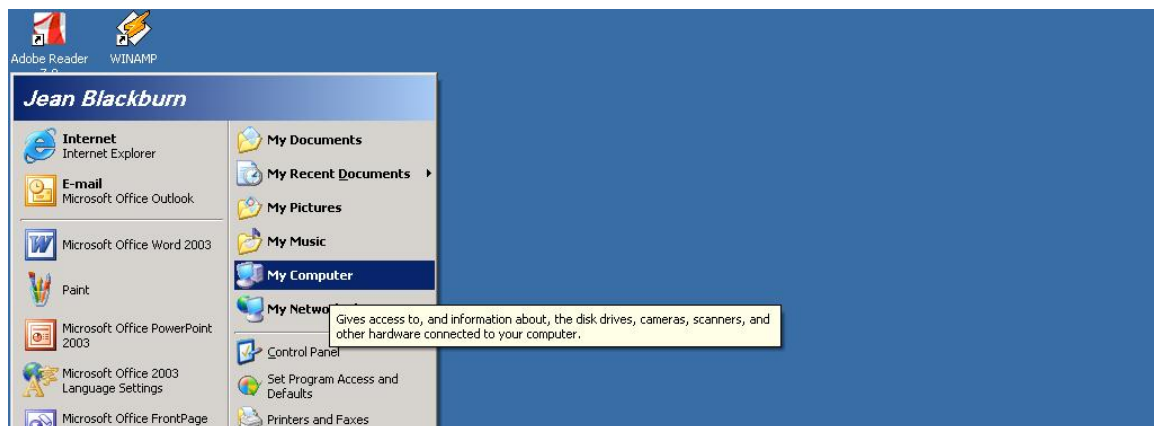
11. Choose the "Nothing. I'm finished working with these pictures" option and click "Next".



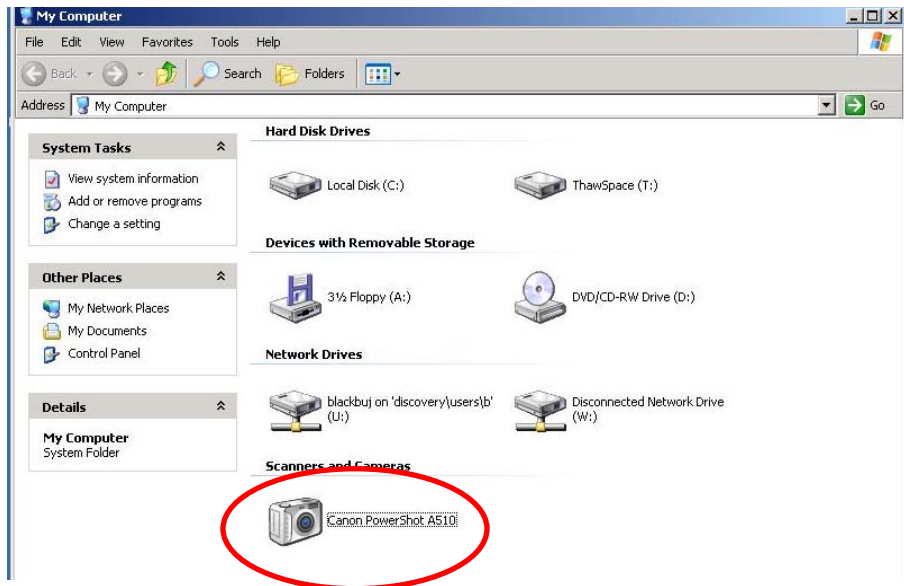
12. Click Finish.



13. You can use My Computer to delete (and also download) pictures on the camera. Open the Start menu and click on My Computer:



14. Double-click on the Canon PowerShot icon:



15. Select what you want to do under “Camera Tasks”. The “Get Pictures from Camera” option will launch the Scanner and Camera Wizard (see Step 7). The “Delete all pictures...” option will remove the pictures from the camera’s storage card.
