Kinesiology is the art and science of human movement, and at VIU, the Kinesiology (Minor) program is your foundation for careers in education, research, rehabilitation sciences (occupational therapy, physical therapy), coaching, personal training, sports administration and many others.

The Kinesiology (Minor) program provides students with the knowledge and experience to pursue careers in education, fitness/wellness management, movement science, outdoor leadership, rehabilitation sciences, coaching, athlete development, and sports administration. Students will explore the nature of human movement and learn essential skills to improve quality of life through activity and exercise. The program provides a broad foundation in many aspects of kinesiology and exposes students to diverse learning environments and applied experiences including lectures, labs, activity classes, online learning, and applied research.
